**NOTE:** To receive the LLWL Certificate of Completion participants are required to complete the Orientation and four seasonal Learning Units. The Spring and Fall Orientation events are held immediately prior to two Learning Units – one weekend, two required units! See the Centre's website to register.

**Goals of the Orientation Event:**

- \* to introduce and clarify the role and function of a Licensed Lay Worship Leader within the UCC;
- \* to provide an opportunity for participants to explore basic elements of UCC worship and concepts of belief; history, ethos and liturgical resources;
- \* to provide an opportunity to participants to reflect on basic competencies and calling.
