



# Herbert S. Sharp Scholarship

This scholarship was established by Herbert S. Sharp, Class of 1890, and is awarded to a student born in New Brunswick, Nova Scotia, or Prince Edward Island, who is Protestant, who is a non-smoker, and who has demonstrated financial need. Preference given to members of the United Church of Canada and to applicants from Prince Edward Island.

## How to Apply:

- Submit an online admissions application to MtA and specify that you are a member of the United Church of Canada within **Section IV Scholarship Donor Criteria** located on the **Entrance Scholarship** tab of the online application. ([mta.ca/apply](http://mta.ca/apply))
- Submit the following supporting documents:
  - Entrance Bursary Application (available online within [Connect@MtA](mailto:Connect@MtA) once admitted)
  - One letter of reference from a minister

**Value:** \$8,000 (\$2,000 per year – renewable upon maintaining 3.3 GPA on full course load)

**Deadline:** An admission application and all supporting documents must be received by **March 1**.
